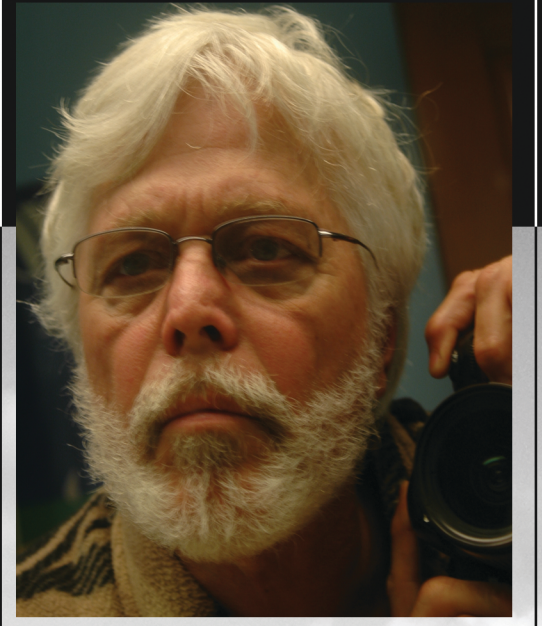


# C. William "Bill" Steele
